What

The Neighbourhood Plan is an extraordinary program with an allocated budget to reverse inequalities among the city's neighbourhoods. The Plan's Advisory Council helps to guide, monitor and evaluate its implementation.

Who

The Advisory Council of the Barcelona Neighbourhoods Program is made up of citizens and professionals of renowned prestige in the fields of urban planning, social services, economic dynamism and citizen associations. The IGOP is represented by professors Ismael Blanco, Oriol Nel-lo, Helena Cruz and Yunailis Salazar, experts in urban planning policies and public management.

Why

The IGOP undertakes basic and applied research in the field of urban planning, social services, economic dynamization and citizen associations. The activities of the Advisory Council of the Neighbourhood Plan are: the preparation of preliminary studies and coordination of the biannual report, as well as advice on the implementation process of the evaluation model of the Neighbourhood Plan.

How

The Advisory Council meets twice a year. The specific functions of the technical support are as follows:

- Support to the tasks of the President and the Secretary (preparation of agendas, meeting materials, dissemination of the Program in academic spaces, etc.).
- Assistance and support to the facilitation and reporting of the Advisory Council meetings.
- Preparation of preliminary studies and coordination of the biannual report.
- Advice on the implementation process of the evaluation model of the Neighbourhood Plan.
