What

IGOP provides methodological consultancy to the Barcelona City Council project "Good Social Practices", which collects and disseminates practices in both internal management and service provision, whether of its own or in participation with the third sector or other administrations. It seeks useful, relevant and significant actions (experiences, projects, activities, actions, etc.) that have achieved good results in a given context and that it is hoped can be transferred to similar contexts.

Who

The consultancy is offered to the Area of Social Rights, Global Justice, Feminisms and LGTBI of the Barcelona City Council, and in particular to the person in charge of the Best Practices project, Yolanda Fierro, through Dr. Núria Reguero.

Why

The methodological and strategic consulting offered by the IGOP contributes to the assessment of each practice as well as to the Good Practices project as a whole. At the same time, it enhances their visibility and the exchange of replicable experiences within and beyond the Social Rights Area.

The Best Social Practices are a way of rewarding the work carried out by different professionals, of accumulating experience and of capitalizing on knowledge. They aim to encourage the active participation of the staff and, at the same time, to spread the knowledge of the organization by promoting the dissemination and exchange of experiences..

How

IGOP is in charge of interviewing the candidate experiences to be part of the Good Social Practices, preparing a preliminary report that is provided to the Evaluation Commission. This Commission uses an assessment rubric, which has been designed and tested by IGOP, which also collaborates in the feedback session with the selected practices, providing a brief diagnosis, as well as proposals to enhance their dissemination. IGOP also contributes to the assessment and dissemination of the Good Social Practices





project itself, and to the preparation of reports and dissemination materials on the transferability of the practices.
